Canada Soccer (CSA), Alberta Soccer Association (ASA), Edmonton Minor Soccer Association (EMSA) and Edmonton North Zone Soccer Association (EMSA North) require each person on the roster to submit the following documents before they can be activated on a roster and coach:	
 Registration with the League Via the EMSA Soccer Portal Submitted/Cleared Security Clearance with Vulnerable Sector Search Team Official code of conduct, reviewed and agreed to (in portal) Code of Conduct to Protect Children, reviewed and agreed to (in portal) Facility Waivers, reviewed and agreed to (in portal) EMSA Rules & Regulations, reviewed and agreed to (prior to season start) Gym Rules read, and agreed to (prior to season start) NCCP Coaching Number obtained and Submitted to the Zone Office Completed and Non-Expired Respect in Sport Certification Current completion or (working towards completion within the season) of the NCCP required courses for the age group you are coaching, including MED. (This is for Coaches and Assistant coaches only). 	S
